- Restructured

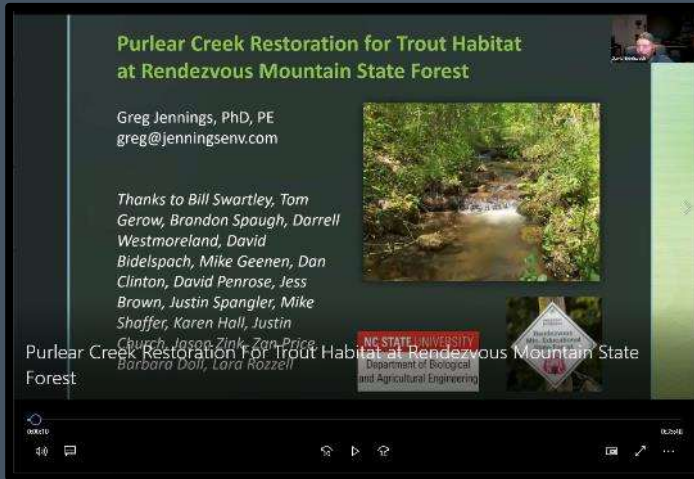

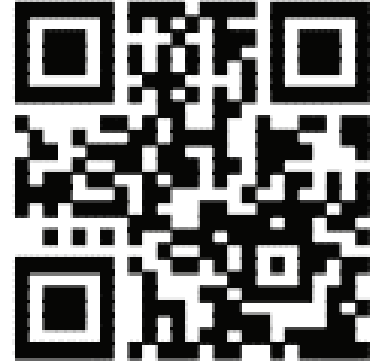
